Retinal Photography

Retinal Photography is state of the art technology that represents the latest in eye disease detection. It allows us to more thoroughly evaluate your retina, the sensitive tissue in your eye that is responsible for vision. The retina is susceptible to a variety of diseases, which can lead to vision loss. Early detection of retinal abnormalities is crucial to protect your vision. The image is kept as a part of your record and we can compare the pictures year after year at your annual examination.

Drs. Staatz and Verachtert highly recommend Retinal Photos, for evaluation and documentation, be performed in addition to your routine examination.

- Everyone, including children, should have baseline photos
- No dilation is necessary to perform this test
- The doctors immediately analyze and review the test with you
- Retinal images are stored for future references and comparison
- You should be tested annually if you have:
 - *Diabetes
 - *Glaucoma
 - *Hypertension
 - *Retinal Problems
 - *Macular Degeneration
 - *High Myopia

This procedure is not covered by basic vision insurance. The fee for retinal photography is 29.00.
